
This is always a huge highlight on Trinity's calendar, and you are invited to bring your family and

Come and join us on Friday 8.00pm to 10.00pm, for a Christmas Party!



The Story Behind Trinity's Christmas Trees

For the past few years, the team of Marinus Kort and Sue van Vuren have decorated the Church, Chapel, prayer chapel and surrounds at Trinity with Christmas trees and decorations. They also saw to it that all the decorations were then taken down and carefully packed away for next year.

At first Marinus adopted the role of the handyman – painstakingly cutting snowflake shapes from thin wood by using a laser. These shapes were then individually painted white by Sue. The next year it was cut out angels that adorned the tree.

Clearly enjoying the task, Sue recalls that she would be reminded each year by Marinus that it would soon be time to put up the Christmas decorations again. Then she would be told of his ideas for the forthcoming celebration. Each year something new. This included changes in the colours used and changes from a busy tree to a simply decorated one – all beautifully done, with much hard work – always accompanied with much laughter, joy and happiness.

Sadly Marinus passed away this year and his commitment, enthusiasm and inspiration will be missed by all. In his memory, his family has agreed to decorate the Christmas tree in the church this year. We thank then for doing so and pray that that this task will give them as much strength and joy, as Marinus found in it.

Pastoral Care 2024 needs YOU!


WE NEED CHAMPIONS FOR THE FOLLOWING AREAS:
