While we wait for our salvation, here are a few things to remember:

- God declares comfort and tenderness for God's people.
- God calls us to prepare a highway in the desert, a highway for God, whose glory would be revealed publicly (40:3-5).
- God's word, unlike the fading and temporary, stays standing forever. It is the word that is the basis of hope and certainty (40:5).
- The church should serve as a herald, as the evangelist of God's coming (40:9-11).
