



Are you ready to write God's way on your heart?

Whenever we step forward to follow the way of Jesus, we respond to God as Jesus did – as a loving relationship of God as our parent – and we share that relationship with Jesus. Our relationship with God reminds us of all the ways the Spirit is bubbling up in different parts of our lives, encouraging and enabling us to live out our side of the relationship. The book of Jeremiah describes it as "writing God's ways on our hearts".

This Sunday at Trinity we celebrate Covenant Services. In the Methodist Church we say and sing and shout that God invites us into devotion, discipleship, dedication, and to work towards social justice. At Covenant Services we can give words and actions to God's invitation as a congregation. As we look forward to the year that unfolds before us, fully aware that God already promises to be with us each step of the way, would you prepare your heart before the services this week, hear again God's promise to us all: "I will be their God and they shall be my people".

What God offers is a loving relationship (this prayer is not a contract!), one that is already freely and graciously at hand. We are invited to experience grace as we settle into our relationship with God through the Covenant and living into it! This is also the challenge of God's invitation: God is committed to our relationship, will you say the words of the Covenant Prayer as a way of acknowledging the relationship and stepping into it?



Friday Night Youth - Gr 8 to Gr 12


This Friday evening, 26 January, our youth will be exploring 'the struggle is real'.

Illuminate: Friday Night Kids - Gr 0 to Gr 7




On Friday evenings our younger kids, Gr 0 to Gr 7, meet for fun, learning, and play. This Friday we are having a sports evening.

The Voters Roll could be closed very soon. The voters roll closes when

the President announces the date of the elections and we don't know when he will do that, but it is most likely in the 'State of the Nation' address of 8th Feb. Therefore time is fast running out.

Although you may not know who to vote for next year, don't let that stop you from making 100% sure that you are properly registered. When the elections come you will want to vote, and if you are not registered you will be turned away.

At this stage it is important to make sure that you are registered to vote.

There are two ways to do that:

A. The easiest way is to go onto the IEC website. Click here: https://www.elections.org.za/

B. You can register physically at community registration day on 3-4 February.
