Let's Build a Bridge – Building Relational Bridges

To successfully love God, love people, and love our nation, we are invited to follow our biblical mandate of reconciling people to God and to each other. This calls for us to become bridge builders who are able to create spaces for people to talk about difficult issues and find new ways to talk, think and act together. Jesus is our bridge builder. This Sunday we learn about bridgebuilding from Jesus as he interacts with the Samaritan woman at the well.

We will hear that bridge building has four phases:

- 1. Clearing away the obstacles that obstruct access to the other side Jesus shows us how he goes about clearing obstacles.
- 2. Building the bridge so that both sides are reachable Jesus models for us how to build bridges.

- 3. Anchoring the keystone, to ensure the bridge stays stable and secure the stability of our bridge should come from a deep and meaningful walk with God.
- 4. Maintaining the structure it's not enough to build the bridge we need to use it by walking across it from both sides.

And we will be treated in each service to hearing a bridge-building story from a Trinity member.

Reading: John 4:1–26 – Jesus and the Samaritan woman at the well.



- that our churches and communities are safe places of hospitality and mutual respect and bridge-building between people.




The Charge

As we started our sermon series, 'What's Your Story?', we asked our congregation members to share with us a word that describes their walk with God, and give us a glimpse of their story.




As part of our 'What's Your Story?' sermon series, we asked our kids to share their prayer requests. Then we wrote them on a canvas.


If you like, you can add your prayer to theirs, and pray right now, where you are, for the kids and their requests.


