Thomas A. Tarrants from the C.S. Institute wrote:

"Have you ever wondered what God wants from you? I don't mean wondering for a few minutes and then coming up with a quick list of do's and don'ts like go to church, give money, read the Bible, pray, do good works, help the needy, and don't commit any of the really bad sins like adultery or murder.

No, I mean seriously and prayerfully seeking God, and asking, "What do You want of me? How do I live the new life You have given me? How do I please and

serve You?"

This is one of the most important questions a believer can ask after coming to salvation"

The "What's Your Story?" sermon series surely triggered, inspired and provoked us to demonstrate love and perform good deeds.




Vacancy in the Trinity Office

Amen"


Disciplines Daily Devotions Book

- With whom do you feel called to start building a bridge? How are you going to do this and how are you going to cross that bridge once it has been built?


• Identify a privilege which you have, and how you may be called to share that with others.


