At least 15 women are murdered and 117 women report rape cases to the police every day in South Africa.

Every. Day.

As a church, Trinity has spent a lot of time this year in prayer for women and children, and the scourge of gender-based and sexual violence. And on Friday we will be joining in with the Women for Change movement, as we spend 15 minutes at noon in prayer and silence, in solidarity with the many women in our congregation, on our staff, in our community, and in our country, who have experienced violence.

We will be posting a prayer on our Facebook and Instagram and WhatsApp channels. In our office, some of us will be participating by spending 15

minutes in dedicated and intentional prayer and silence. Many of us have turned our profile pictures purple, and we will be wearing black. We are inviting you to join us as we do this.

Our prayer chapel is also open and available for you to join us there in prayer, and you are welcome to pop in.




