The focus for our first session will be: *'Reflection on Our Personal*

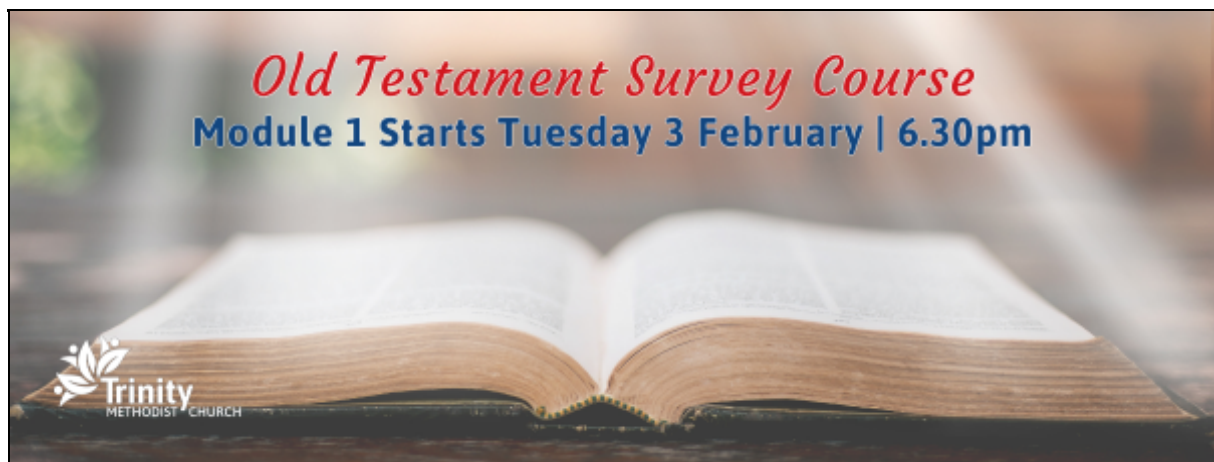
Understanding, Knowledge and Behaviour Towards Others Who Are Different from Ourselves – and To Embrace the Differences in Trinity Methodist Church'.

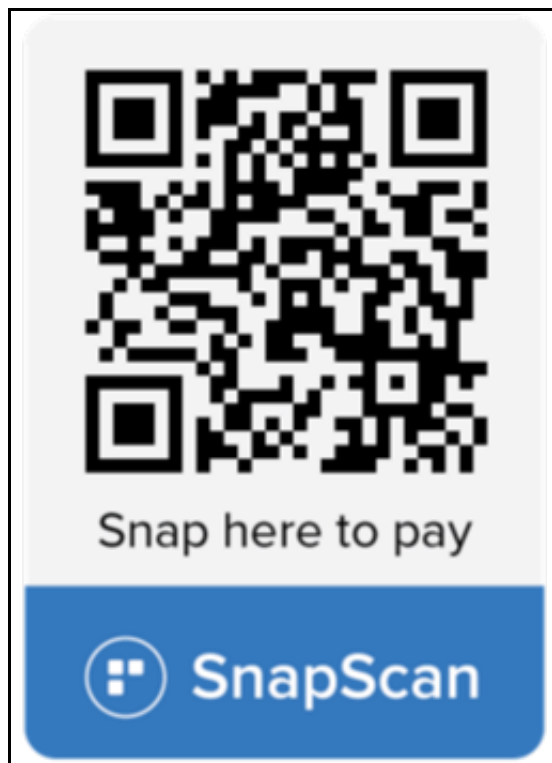
